I am excited to announce the launch of our new 2 semester EMT to Paramedic Program at Rappahannock Community College (RCC), with the option to test at AEMT after the first semester beginning the Fall of 2024.

EMS providers currently certified at the AEMT and Intermediate level may be eligible to complete the program in one semester.

RCC is dedicated to meeting the needs of EMS agencies and this new program will significantly reduce the cost and time to earn a paramedic certificate without compromising quality of prepartion.

Students must attend one of the mandatory orientations for Fall 2024: July 17th at 7 pm at the Glenns Campus July 22nd at 1 pm at the Kilmarnock Campus July 31st at 10 am at the Warsaw Campus

NOTES:

- All currently certified EMT-Intermediates are exempt from EMS 221 and EMS 222 (4 total credits)
- EMS 221, 222, 223 and 224 will be offered on a flip-flop schedule depending upon sufficient enrollment, students must attend one complete day/week of class plus field/clinical shifts
- Students may conduct clinical shifts at any Riverside, Sentara, Bon Secours-Mercy, and VCU-Tappahannock Hospital
- Students may conduct field shifts with home agency if they are not considered to be part of daily minimal staffing
- EMS 241 and 249 are scheduled around student and clinical/field availability
- EMS 163, 164, 165, 167 are offered through RCC as 2-day classes
- Field and clinical requirement completion is dependent upon Student Minimum Competencies and not on minimum hour requirements
- If a student possesses a card that will remain current throughout the course and NREMT testing, it can be submitted for credit (EMS 163, 164, 165, 167) and \$160.65/course can be subtracted from overall cost
- RCC is in the top 5% of Paramedic Programs in the Commonwealth and students are eligible for VA OEMS Scholarships
- Students may be eligible for financial aid through RCC
- FA24 Registration is currently open
- A student may register for classes and the agency be invoiced for payment (if applicable)
